erall Role

The VAFA is Australia's oldest and largest football competition consisting of 70 clubs and 300+ teams competing in men's and women's competitions across senior, reserve, thirds, under-19 and master's sections.

The role will:

- Manage VAFA strategic outcomes specifically related to club development
- Manage key outcomes from the Tackle Your Feelings (TYF) project
- Work closely with AFL Victoria Football Development Manager network to plan, access and implement key development and sustainability programs to achieve strategic outcomes of the VAFA
- Work with all VAFA stakeholders including other football competitions, clubs, coaches, umpires, volunteers and sponsors to support the long-term sustainability of all VAFA clubs

- A preparedness to work extended hours including afterhours meetings during the football season
