Together we Achieve More

Once again, I want to celebrate the return of VAFA football. With Rounds 1 and 2 under our belts, I want to make a few observations.

Last week, I touched on challenges we faced with a shortage of umpires and the late timing of our advice to clubs requiring already loaded club volunteers to perform Houdini type feats and find more officials. The umpiring matter became more than what was explained from an operations perspective, with elements of the feedback referring to gender equity.

While social media is a tool our clubs use to celebrate team performances and their players and members, it is disappointing when individual members misuse it to promulgate misinformation and negativity. It is timely to remind our community that the VAFA's *Social Media & Digital Communication Policy* extends to players and officials on any social media channel or online forum and misuse, as outlined in the policy, will not be tolerated, and will be investigated.

The VAFA has the single largest women's football competition in community football in Australia, combined Awards Nights and Media Days, (3) female Board Members, (9) female Club Presidents, a Women's Advisory Group and we are currently working to strengthen female representation on our Board. As an Association, we pride ourselves on our inclusivity among all members, irrespective of gender. We recognise issues will arise and we will always strive to resolve them.

Round 2 threw up another challenge with the return of all community football competitions and the subsequent slow loading of results and ladders via SportsTG. SportsTG provides the competition management system for the VAFA and all community football leagues and, despite efforts to obtain our own data over the years, this is out of our control. The issue of slow load times is not due to the VAFA website but instead the SportsTG links. Since

investing heavily and making significant upgrades to the hosting platform (Amazon Web Services) for VAFA.com.au, our website's load times are quicker and more efficient than they've ever been.

I would like to thank our community for the incredible uptake of the digital Amateur Footballer Record over the past two weeks. The change from hard copy to soft copy was flagged with clubs via surveys in 2019 and again in 2020, with the majority recognising the financial benefit of moving to a digital version. While clubs are progressively sending their team lists through for inclusion in the record, the ability to download directly to smartphones and the use of printed QR codes at club canteens over the weekend saw a great number of eyeballs reading over our 64-page record. While there is a

small group unhappy with the decision to go digital in 2021, we hope the transition is made easier via the numerous methods we've provided to make it accessible for all.

Garnering support will always provide more positive outcomes for everyone than negative attitudes and unhelpful pot shots. Given where we all were 12 months ago, I know which situation I prefer.

So, let's work together and celebrate what's great about the VAFA rather than trying to tear down the great competition we all love.

This Anzac Day long weekend is a time to remember those who tragically passed away in war defending the rights of Australians. Whilst not actually participating on Anzac Day, many clubs will be conducting services to honour the Anzacs this Saturday, predominantly during the interval between the reserves and the seniors. We encourage everyone to take a moment to remember. Lest we forget.

Anzac Day weekend brings about some real blockbusters, commencing with the RSN Carnival Match of the Day between **Old Scotch** and **Collegians** from Camberwell Sports Ground. Both sides experienced losses last weekend and will be keen to bounce back in a game each would consider winnable. After defeating Trinity by 11 goals in Round 1, Scotch struggled to score in their clash with Xavs and continually broke down entering 50. While missing key personnel – Gene van den Broek and Charlie Cormack – they will be buoyed by the performances of their talented pups – Ryan Valentine, Harry Stubbings and Tom Ansell in the ruck. Yet to win a game, Collegians failed to fire in a game most considered theirs to lose. While they await the return of injured skipper, Sam Hibbins, David Mirra has quickly become a fan-favourite with another four goals and dominant performance last week. 0-2, this is a must-win for the Lions. You can tune into all the action from 1pm with the 'Saturday Warm-Up' before the Match of the Day broadcast from 2pm on RSN Carnival.

As two of just three undefeated sides in William Buck Premier, the modern rivalry between **St Kevin's OB** and **Old Xaverians** is set to light up TH King Oval. Xavs put one rival away when they defeated Scotch by 94 points last week, proving they're a genuine contender in 2021. It was their half-back line that refused to allow the Cards any momentum, with Jordan Kelly, Will Hams, Joseph Ayton-Delaney and Alex Triggar standouts. SKOB enter this clash with serious momentum after coming from 22 points down against Brighton and running out three-point winners. Another five goals from Tom Boyd opens the door to a potential mouth-watering clash with Ryan Schoenmakers – if the VAFA Gods are so kind.

St Bernard's will look to make it two in a row when they host **Old Trinity** at the Snakepit. The Snow Dogs were valiant against Xavs in Round 1 and took their form to another level with a seven-point win over Collegians at

the Trott. The T's, on the other hand, will be looking to bounce back from two disappointing losses and a leg injury to Gabe Hamilton. Their final term against OM's was a highlight and, if they can continue that form, they're not without a chance against their 2015 nemesis.

OM's will try to maintain their unbeaten run against **University Blues** at the Uni Oval. Through quarters 2-3, OM's were untouchable last week and piled on 10 goals to three against the T's. Jackson Paine kicked four but looks ready to explode any moment now, while Ned Nichols mounted his case to be named the Rising Star winner after Round 2. They do, however, face the reigning premiers after the Blues returned to their winning ways against Caulfield. Another four goals from Sam Grimley excites, but four from Kieran Harper could spell danger for everyone.

In the final match, we have **Old Brighton** hosting **Caulfield Grammarians** at Brighton Beach. The fourth-placed Tonners failed to stave off SKOB after leading by 22 at the last break, but will be more than happy with the continued strong form of Will Lewis up forward. As for the Fields, they too started strongly in their match with the Blues and led by 13 at the half but were overrun in the second half. Young gun Cody Hennes top scoring with four will get the supporters up and about, but only one from Brett Eddy means he could ignite at any stage now.

Blackers outlast Tigers as Willy CYMS salute in Premier B

The dizzying heights of Prem B proved to be no issue for Matthew Montebello and the CY's as they overcame a slow start to overrun De La at Fearon Reserve. Meanwhile, the Bloods claimed their first four-points on the season in a dismantling win over Old Carey. In other results across the weekend, Fitzroy took care of business against Parkdale while Uni Blacks and Beaumaris kept their unblemished record alive with comprehensive victories.

Despite a gruesome injury in the dying stages that marred a fantastic afternoon, **Williamstown CYMS** registered their first Premier B victory in their club's history, downing **De La Salle** by 19-points at Fearon Reserve. Booting 12-goals to seven after quarter time, the CYs overcame a goalless opening term to put a disappointing Round 1 result behind them and start their 2021 campaign. Ruckman Dylan Jones and young gun Max Philpot were instrumental in getting the ball forward, helping five different CYs bag multiple majors. The always reliable Sean Fisher was named De La's best while Tom Humphrey moved forward for three goals. After dispatching one former William Buck Premier side, Williamstown CYMS will now turn their attention to the struggling Panthers, while De La will be eager to get back on the winners list and send a message in the process, welcoming the unbeaten Uni Blacks to Waverley Oval.

In an emotional afternoon for everyone involved at Princes Park, **Old Haileyburians** paid tribute to Danny Frawley in "Spud's Game" by tearing apart **Old Carey** by 85-points. Using the importance of the day as wind in the sails, the Bloods overwhelmed the Panthers across the paddock and on the scoreboard, piling on 35-scoring shots to 10 in a dominant performance. Star Durras Secull continued his strong start to the year with another four majors while key-forward Sam Loewe also bagged four. Captain James Paul was adjudged best afield in the outing. Lachlan Senior was named Carey's best as he did all he could in picking up the slack of the missing Harry Hill, while Captain Zander Adam also stood tall. The Bloods will now travel to Brindisi Street Oval for a huge clash with the Tigers while Carey look to get on the board against the CYs.

Gerry Green Reserve played host to a second-half masterclass from Luke Mahoney and **Fitzroy** as they put **Parkdale Vultures** to the sword with a 110-point thumping. Slamming home 18-majors to three after half-time, the Roys were unstoppable once they went inside-50 with 13 individual goal-kickers. Young gun Jack Hart moved forward for a bag of four majors while Jack Dalton and Jack McKay both kicked three. Ted Clayton was once again outstanding in the middle while recruit Tom Wilson also fared well in his first win in the red, gold and blue. The Vultures continue to work through a tough 2021 to grow and improve their playing group, with some growing pains now that will bear fruit in coming seasons. Mitchell Hart kicked two in his second game for the club while Cooper Balic and Mitch Tsiros can hold their

head high. The Roys will look to go streaking as they welcome a tough AJAX outfit to Brunswick Street Oval while Parkdale head to Banksia Reserve to tackle the Sharks.

After pushing aside one former Premier C team last weekend in Williamstown CYMS, **Beaumaris** followed it up with another strong performance, downing **AJAX** by 43-points at Gary Smorgen Oval at Albert Park. Holding the Jackas to just five majors for the afternoon (three after quarter-time), it was once again the Sharks vicelike defensive unit led by Scott Gower that played a huge part in earning the four-points. Chris Grigoriadis followed up from his performance last weekend with another three majors while Sam Gibbins returned to the line-up after a stint in the WGFNC, also kicking three. Lewis Diggins was named best afield for his role on the half-back flank. Nick Cohen followed up from a strong Round 1 performance with another three majors for the Jackas while captain Nick Lewis was judged his sides best on the day. The Sharks now return home to take on a young Vultures side while AJAX will look to get back on the winning list with a clash against Fitzroy.

Despite playing without a bench for majority of the match due to injuries, the **University Blacks** managed to scrounge out a memorable character building 22-point victory over a tough **St Bedes/Mentone Tigers** side at Uni Oval. Ruling out Joel Ernest, Darren Mumford, Mitch Rodd and Matt Goyder prior to half-time, the Blackers were able to miraculously boot five of the final six goals of the game to pull out a victory that is a sign of a true Premiership contender. Alastair Robbins was instrumental up-forward as a key marking target with three majors while Louis Vescio broke the game open in the final term with two of his three goals separating the sides. Jack Charleston was named best afield in a memorable afternoon. James Mangoni was unstoppable up-forward for Bedes with six majors in a masterful performance, but the overwhelming thought of letting one slip will be tough to shake for Adrian McBean's men. Uni Blacks will now retool and regroup for a run at De La at Waverley Oval while the Tigers return to the confines of Brindisi Street for a mouth-watering clash with Haileybury.

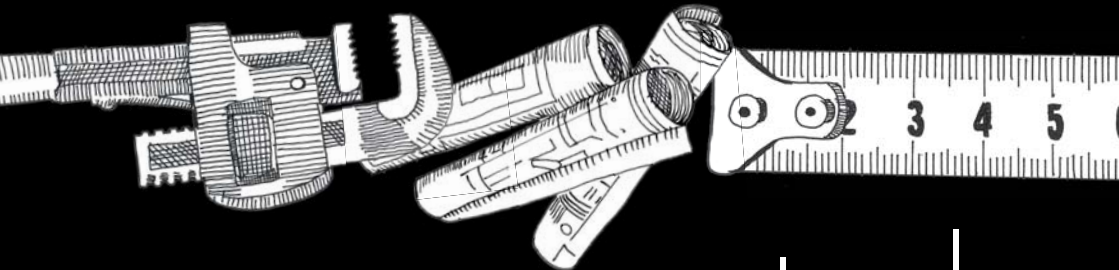

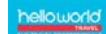

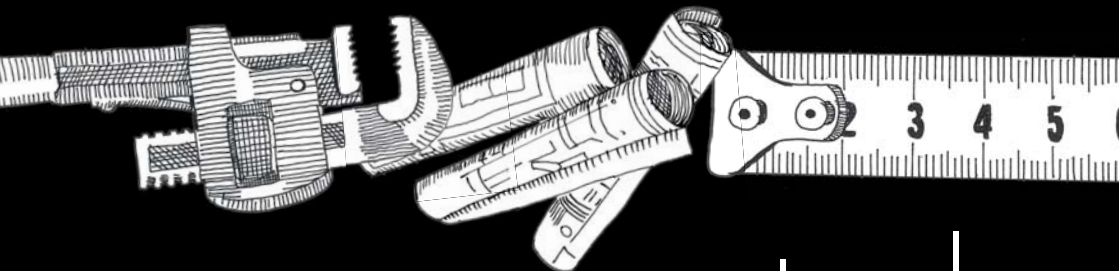
