EDITORIAL

Women's Finals Kick-Off

This weekend marks 12 months since VAFA football was last played in 2021. For our women's competitions, one team had secured a Grand Final berth, and two teams were ready to battle out the Preliminary Final before the season was ultimately cancelled.

That didn't impact Fitzroy, who were knocked out in the first week of the Premier B Women's finals in 2021. Yet the women from Brunswick Street Oval have qualified on top of the Premier B Women's ladder in 2022 and

will take on Old Brighton with confidence in the second semifinal to be played at Coburg City Oval this weekend.

In Premier C Women's, last season was abandoned with St Bedes/Mentone Tigers preparing for a Preliminary final contest. This year they have gone undefeated, winning all 14 home and away games and creating a new record in conceding the lowest points against in a single season (96) at an average of only 6.8 points

per game. On the scoring front, the Tigers have been led brilliantly by Madi Wilson, the leading goalkicker for the Premier C competition with 26 goals for the season. No doubt they will be red hot favourites for their semi-final against Parkdale Vultures.

Last year in Division 1 Women's, Beaumaris were also awaiting a Preliminary final contest when the season was abandoned. In 2022, they have responded in exactly the same fashion as St Bedes/Mentone, putting together an undefeated home and away season and going into this week's semi-final at home against Old Haileybury as hot favourites.

In Division 2 Women's, Hampton Rovers had gualified

for the 2021 Grand Final and were waiting to see who their opponents would be. Fast forward a season, and the Rovers have put together another undefeated season. In fact, they are on a 23 game winning streak, with their last loss coming in the 2019 Grand Final at the hands of Preston Bullants. Hampton will assume home ground advantage as they host Albert Park in this weekend's semi-final.

We should celebrate the fact that we are having a finals series this year and wish all teams the best of luck.

In Division 3 Women's, the MCC have also turned in an undefeated season in 2022, after being left high and dry in a Preliminary Final position in Division 4 in 2021. MCC will take on second placed Bulleen Templestowe, whom they only overcame by 1 point when the two teams met in Round 4 this year, so this final looms as a cracking game.

And in amongst all the ladder leaders mentioned above there

are only two teams that can actually go on to claim the title of "back-to-back premiers".

In Premier B Women's, Old Scotch (who finished the 2022 season in 4th place) are the reigning 2019 Division 1 Flag holders. Whilst in Division 1 Women's, Therry Penola (who also finished this season in 4th position) are the reigning 2019 Division 2 Premiers.

We should celebrate the fact that we are having a finals series this year and wish all teams the best of luck.

Are we set for a weekend of 'classic 8-point games' or will recent history continue?

While I love nothing more than looking at the head-to-head battles across William Buck Premier. The grumpiest man in the competition Brian Waldron loves nothing more than using the phrase "classic 8-point game" which to me is a complete fallacy. Every game will only ever be worth 4-points. This week I'm attempting to find common ground with my smiling-grumpy colleague in an aim to meet in the middle.

Last week our old friend was boasting about getting 5/5, and he would have been accurate. Had St Bernard's not beaten Caulfield, had Old Xaverians not thrashed Old Scotch and had the Old Melburnians not run out of time against University Blues.

So while he goes for "feel" I'll use my VAFA Champion Data style calculator to assist the rest of us as we look ahead to a massive Round 14

Out at Camberwell Sports Park, **Old Scotch** won't find themselves in an easy contest against **St Bernard's**. The Cardinals were stunned in the opening 30 minutes against Collegians in Round 13 and chased the tail of the Lions for the rest of the afternoon. Getting to within 19 points during the final quarter, but never able to cause a significant dent in the momentum of the purple army.

If they're fortunate enough to keep Doug Lawrence from the VFL, if they're bringing back Aiden Franetic and Tom Ansell holds out Zac O'Halloran in the ruck, that will go a long way in itself to winning this game. St Bernard's last weekend ended a run of nine consecutive losses, finally there's something to smile about from the boys of Essendon. Accuracy in front of goal certainly helped, for just the second time this year they were able to kick 10 goals for the game.

Despite Waldron being very complimentary towards the Cardinals last week, he has forecast this to be a 'danger game' given their spot on the ladder. If they're to completely close the door on relegation discussions, and St Bernard's hopes of getting out of the bottom two, they can't afford to be off their game.

Old Scotch have won the last 4 meetings against St Bernard's. History is set to continue on the trajectory this weekend. Save the line of the 'classic 8-point game for next time.

Old Xaverians did to Old Brighton what St Kevin's did to them before the double bye. Set up the victory in the first quarter. And, don't let up from there. What a day to be aligned with Xav's, an opening term blitz. Followed by a final quarter trouncing.

Sometimes you get moments within a game, and games within a season when it all just clicks. This could be that moment for the red and black mafia. No surprise again, Xavier Richards plays and kicks another four goals. Seven games this year, 28 goals. He hasn't stepped off his 4-goal average since his debut in 2021 with the club.

Apart from moments in the third quarter for the Tonners, there was little to no reprieve or let up from the travelling side. Hellbent on keeping in touch with the top three, while keeping this weekend's opponent at bay. The club, so impressed with the performance, moved to lock away senior coach James Byrne earlier this week for season 2023 and 2024.

Collegians (this weekend's opponent) started just as emphatically as Xav's and are certainly in a better position this time around to contend with the A-Grade rivals. 5-wins on the trot from the boys of Harry Trott. Dave Mirra (27 goals for the year), Ed Greene (24 goals) will be a challenge for the defence of Xavier.

At home, I can't wait to watch Sam Hibbins, Kenny Ong do battle with Marcus Stavrou and Dan Robinson. Nor will I be able to take my eyes off Matt Warren vs. Xavier Richards up forward.

The number #1 ranked side of the last five rounds, against the side that announced themselves last weekend. History is on the side of Old Xaverians having won the past three encounters, but this moment trumps the history card and falls the way of the classic 8-point game. The winner is outright fourth with a month to play.

Old Brighton have won the last 3 against **Old Trinity.** The T's are hanging perilously to eighth spot on the table. Prior to last weekend they had a 2-game gap on University Blues and St Bernard's, it's now just one. And, should results fall the way of both those sides, the lowly percentage the green and gold have will really hurt them come 5pm Saturday.

It may be the least opportune time to run into Old Brighton. Despite the last five games going loss, win, loss, win, loss. You have to go back to Round one and Round two of season 2019 the last time they dropped back-to-back games. Greg Hutchison, and the 22 selected won't allow what happened on Saturday against Old Xavier to happen again.

Similar to Xav's at Brighton, and Collegians in Camberwell. Old Trinity were jumped by St Kevin's in the opening term, and trailed by 21 points. The positive for the T's from beyond quarter time, on the scoreboard, they finished 21 points behind at the end of the game. Staying the final three quarters with the ladder leaders. Myles Scott is proving to be a danger forward for them with goals in three of his last 4 matches.

History favours Old Brighton every way you look at it. Statistically it also falls in their favour. And it's tough to see how Old Trinity can overcome them this weekend.

The RSN Carnival Match of the Day is headed out to Glen Huntly Oval. **Old Melburnians** have won the last 4 over **Cauffield Grammarians**. I can't see for a moment Paul Satterley leaving the door slightly open at all for the Fields this week after having the game taken away from them in the final term last weekend.



Earlier this year Caulfield were in the box seat to bury OM's had it not been for inaccuracy in front of goal at Elsternwick Park. This Saturday, at home. Julian Dobosz has a real opportunity with a slightly weakened OM's defence to get up the ground and send home long-range bombs.

In the last three losses Caulfield has experienced, they've averaged 54 points for. While conceding an average of 74 points in those games. While I can't see Satts leaving the door open, I am very excited to see the Fields midfield face off with the OM's brigade. Declain Reilly, up against Nick De Steiger is where it will all start.

History is on the side of OM's in the head-to-head battle, they'd like history to repeat itself this weekend to stay in touch with the top two sides. Caulfield, need to buck the history trend to eliminate discussion of them in the relegation zone.

After not meeting in 2021, the two most recent Premiers. University Blues and St Kevin's will face off at Melbourne Uni. Unfortunately for the Blues, the dominance of St Kevin's came to the fore as they ran over the top of them in the final quarter.

The head-to-head battle has the ledger squared at 2-all in the previous four meetings. The Grand Final of 2019 is too far gone, and counts for nothing this Saturday. The teams, and coaching staff of both sides are completely different.

The trajectory these teams are now on, are completely different. A St Kevin's win almost certainly gives them a lock for top two given Old Scotch (6th), Caulfield (7th), and St Bernard's (10th) are to come in three of their final four matches. If Uni Blues can win at home (for the first time since round 8) and Old Trinity lose, it gets them out of the bottom two and sets up a big round 15 where they'll face the T's at Melbourne Uni to extend out of the relegation zone.

Even though they had to come from behind to win it, and a stroke of good fortune. The messaging from Uni Blues during this week is there was a glint in the eye heading into the game after being flatted the week before.

They can't play off this September from where they're at, but they can certainly shape who does play off in September and the finishing order of the top four. On the ladder itself, it all points to St Kevin's, once the balls bounced, it's a toss of the coin.

Who will fill the final spots on the podium in Premier B Men's?

It was survival of the fittest this week with a dreary day around the grounds providing some less-than-ideal conditions. Beaumaris pulled off another stellar win, defeating AJAX by 89-points, meanwhile St Bedes/ Mentone Tigers got to work against Old Carey in their 36-point victory. The Uni Blacks have their season well and truly back on track, overcoming Fitzroy by 28 points and De La Salle brought the heat, beating Old Haileybury by 9 points. The tight race for third place is on as Old Haileybury, Fitzroy and AJAX all sit on 24 points. All eyes will be watching closely to see who nabs themselves a finals position.

Beaumaris reminded us all of their strength this week, as they were crowned victorious over AJAX. Beauy's might around the ground was highlighted though Sam Gibbins and Damien Johns as their hard work had The Sharks in front by 18 points at quarter time. Matthew Petering and Joel Cusack's forward line intensity were essential to Beauy's success with the pair kicking 3 and 2 respectively. Elliot Debinski's pressure off The Jacker's half backline troubled The Sharks coupled with consistent second and third spoil attempts from Adam Caplan. This contributed to inaccuracy in front of goal with Beaumaris kicking 12 points in the back end of the game. Ultimately, it was The Sharks that controlled this game, recording a final score of 17.22-124 to AJAX 5.5-35. Beauy have solidified their position as a force to be reckoned with this season, as no bottom sides are yet to come close to The Sharks. Suring up to finals, if any of the third-place contenders are to snatch the crown, they'll have to go through Beaumaris first. Beauy certainly have momentum on their side as they face Williamstown in round 14. With back-to-back home games for AJAX, they must continue their hard work, especially against the Uni Blacks next week. With their finals hopes still alive, The Jackers can't take their foot off the gas just yet.

St Bedes/Mentone Tigers return home with the four points, defeating **Old Carey** by 36-points at the Carey Sports Complex. The light at the end of the tunnel is beginning to shine for the Tigers after a tough couple of weeks have finally resulted in some wins on the board. Christopher Mangoni's persistence over the past few rounds was clear this weekend as his hard work and leadership were pivotal in this victory. Brayden O'Toole played his role in front of goal recording 4 goals as did Lachlan Willey with his 3. With Old Carey's future now heading in the Premier C direction, The Panthers can work to unite their playing group for the last few rounds and end the year with some positive learnings. SBMT currently sit on 20 points, just shy of playing finals. Could they join the race for the top four? An all-important game against The Roys at Brunswick Street Oval could determine their September plans. No reprieve for Old Carey in round 14 as they face finals hopefuls in Old Haileybury

Melbourne University Oval hosted the battle between the **Uni Blacks** and **Fitzroy**, with the Blackers coming out on top. The Roys remained competitive with the Blackers for most of the day, trailing by 4 points at the quarter-time siren. Jack Mckay worked tirelessly through the middle with support from Donovan Toohey.

Rhys Seakins and Nathan Ligris worked hard all day to keep the Uni Blacks at bay, spoiling a number of crucial forward line entries. The composure of Henry Bennett and Bede Mahon ultimately saw the Uni Blacks keep control of the game's momentum, with Nicholas Caris and Angus Mckinna, both securing themselves 2 goals each. With a final score of 8.15-63 to Fitzroy's 5.5-35, the Blackers have officially rebuilt their winning streak. In the week to come, the Uni Blacks are up against AJAX down at Gary Smorgon Oval while The Roys are presented with a makeor-break opportunity to keep their spot in the four as they look forward to St Bedes/Mentone.



Top 4 vs Bottom 4 in the penultimate round of William Buck Premier Women's

With a fortnight of the home and away season to go in William Buck Premier Women's, the top four sides are set. The jostling for positions is still alive and well, and as we move into this week, the bottom four face the top four with a chance of feathers being ruffled high on the forecast.
