- Player & Team Development: Working with individuals and groups to prepare players for competitive football.
- Strategy: Working closely with the coaching group to implement a consistent club strategy and game plan.
- **Culture:** Promotion of the club's values, and working with club committee to prioritise player welfare and overall health of the club.
